
GC Synod Women's Bible Study Event Saturday, January 7, 2017 Lord of Life Lutheran Sun City West, AZ

## Message from your new President, Myrna

Advent greetings to you!

I was elected your president at the convention in Las Vegas in November. I'm a year-round resident of Scottsdale, having moved here four years ago from the shores of Lake Superior in Duluth, MN, with my husband, Bob Ulland. Since arriving in the NE Valley conference area, I've had the privilege of getting involved with our Grand Canyon Women of the ELCA and have served on your board for three years. Thank you to each of the 2014-2016 outgoing board members who served so faithfully and whose terms ended with the convention. We expect to see all of you continuing to be active in our synod in new ways!

I'm excited to join your newly elected board in providing support and leadership to you, our sisters in faith all across the Grand Canyon synod. Your new board is committed to living out our purpose statement and forging ahead under the theme of "All Anew!" You'll find the names and contact information for all of us on page 11 of this issue. We want to hear from you about how we can work together in women's ministry.

Our convention/gathering in Las Vegas was well attended and had many opportunities to witness how God is at work among us, acting through us, and how we are serving God through serving others. We learned more about Human Trafficking, Youth Drug Addictions, the Native American ministries in our synod, how to Build Women's Ministries, and PV for Phebe. There was a round table for Treasurers, and our Partners in Ministry (formerly called "vendors") brought ideas to take back to your units. We had 13 scholarship recipients, including representatives from all three of our Lutheran Campus Ministry programs. One of the highlights of this year's event was a Silent Auction and the \$2407 proceeds will fund future scholarships to our synod women's retreats and conventions. 24 churches were represented. Our youngest woman attending was 19 years old, and the most senior among us was 89. Thank you to Suki Kisling, our convention coordinator/planner/energizer bunny extraordinaire, and her team of volunteers who worked tirelessly to bring many new features to our time together. From those in attendance at the convention/gathering, we asked for, and received, feedback about what the women enjoyed and what they'd like to see changed. And we got what we asked for! 99 responses filled with comments! Thank you. Your voices have been heard. At the convention portion of our time together in Las Vegas, we passed one resolution that I want to share with you. 2017 will truly be a year of celebration as we commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Reformation and recognize that our Women of the ELCA women's ministry was created 30 years ago. It's also the year of the 10th Triennial Gathering in Minneapolis. Here are the "resolves" of the resolution that was adopted:

- That we celebrate our Lutheran heritage in 2017 by encouraging the reading and discussion of Martin Luther's Small Catechism and learning anew "what does this mean?"
- That we encourage women from every congregation in our synod to attend the 2017 Triennial Gathering in Minneapolis on July 13-16, 2017
- That we, as Grand Canyon Women of the ELCA, recommit ourselves to seeking out opportunities for fellowship, study and learning together to re-energize our women's ministry programs.

Finally, I want to extend God's richest blessings to our retiring GC Synod Women's President, Laura Krueger, who completed her term of office in November. Laura has provided leadership to our synod women for five years and was honored with a generous gift from the outgoing board to our June Klaar scholarship fund. She deserves some rest (even though she's a very busy woman) but has promised to stay connected. Thank you, Laura!

May the Christ of Christmas bring new light and life to each of you as we close out this year and continue on our journey of faith and fellowship. Have yourselves a very, merry Christmas! I'll be seeing you around!

There was a record 53 'First Timers' and all three Arizona universities were represented. Thanks to the Conferences who picked up the Scholarship tab for Campus Ministries.


Based on past evaluations, several changes were made in the format of the Convention. A private prayer room, with candles





She is coming back as the Keynote speaker in Minneapolis. Leymah is a Lutheran and a peace activist from Liberia, Africa where she is known for assembling thousands of women, Christians and Muslims, to pray in the streets eventually putting an end to the 2003 Civil War. Her story and her stamina are amazing! She told her own story in the January/February 2005 issue of Lutheran Women Today, titled 'Persistence and Peace'.


