President: For many years I have listened and watched the women in all the congregations that have blessed my faith journey thus far. It would have been a long trek in the desert without the women of my congregations who teach me, sustain me, lift me up, straighten me out, make me laugh, let me cry and keep me excited as we continue to take time to Listen for God's call. Beyond the safety of my congregation the

experience is the same with the women I've met at conference and synod gatherings. As Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America, what we do is awesome and immeasurable, even when done quietly.

Earnestlee: Is that so Susan. That's beautiful! Thanks for sharing your observations with us.

President: The Women of the ELCA synodical board recognizes that the annual convention is our most important opportunity for growth and development as an organization and as sisters in Christ. Your board strives to keep the cost of attending the convention affordable to all who wish to attend. In doing so Scholarships are available for women to attend who may not be able to attend a WELCA event

WELCAettes: WELCA – Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America

Earnestlee: sounds like a great idea – I also heard you sisters in Christ provided a scholarship for a friend of mine. She went to her first Grand Canyon convention back in the 90's as a scholarship recipient and that's when she got all hipped up about WELCA....

WELCAettes: WELCA – Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America

Earnestlee: after that convention. She kept talking about the great women she met, the new friends she made and how moving the worship was and how the music was incredible – she couldn't stop talking about how spiritually uplifted she was after that convention –so what are scholarships and who qualifies?

President: Scholarships are awarded each year to allow women who have never attended a synod convention before to come to one. Two of the scholarships cover the registration fee and hotel cost of the recipient. These are for young women, one for those under 30 yrs old and the other for young women under age 40. There are also scholarships for women from the 9 conferences. One is given from each conference to a woman of any age who has not attended a synod convention and the other is for a Woman of color and/or whose primary language is other than English. These scholarships are a great way for us to hear God's call and support the WELCA purpose statement...

WELCAettes: Purpose – As a community of women created in the image of God, called to discipleship in Jesus Christ, and empowered by the Holy Spirit, we commit ourselves to grow in faith, affirm our gifts, support one another in our callings, engage in ministry and action and promote healing and wholeness in the church, the society and the world.

Earnestlee: Oh Susan, it was so nice chatting with you, gotta go, another call's coming in.... One Ringie Dingie..... Two Ringie Dingie..... This is Earnestlee Tomlin with the Grand Canyon Telephone Company with a gracious good morning to you.... Is this the party to whom I am speaking? *(snort)*

Mission Action: Hello Earnestlee, this is Susan Bye, from the SWO's...

WELCAettes: SWO – Synodical Women's Organization

Mission Action: Mission: Action Committee. Our committee encourages women to put their faith into action. Women are encouraged to show their discipleship through stewardship of time, talent and resources; showing acts of faith and justice; by supporting other women as they articulate and act upon their faith; by staying informed about local, national and international issues related to human needs, peace with justice and the environment; by communicating support for the oppressed through advocacy and partnerships; and promoting education on justice issues.

Earnestlee: Wow, your committee seems like they have a lot to do.

Mission: Action: During this last year, we encouraged women and their families to get involved in the Cell phone project. Did you know that Americans change their cell phones about once a year totaling about half a billion a year. That means about 11 million cell phones head to the landfills every year. By collecting old cell phones, we were able to impact positively the environment. In addition, the money collected as reusable materials in the donated cell phones was used to benefit women and children living in poverty. Other projects included providing awareness about the Stand with Africa Water Project, and Lutheran Campus Ministry programs here in the Grand Canyon Synod.

Earnestlee: Who knew one little old dead cell phone could do so much damage and also so much good! I'm never going to throw out my cell phones again. Your committee deserves major kudos for a job well done!

Mission: Action: Well, Earnestlee. We also encourage women and their congregational units to get involved with Fair Trade Products. By purchasing these products we are helping people around the world move from poverty to prosperity. Have you tried the great coffee and that chocolate is to die for!

Earnestlee: Now you're talking girl!

Mission: Action: Our work is not yet done. I'm not sure it will ever be done. As WELCA....

WELCAettes: WELCA – Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America

Mission: Action: women, we need to be advocates for those who cannot speak for themselves. We need to listen to God's Call..... and put our Faith into Action.

Canyon Echoes: Well, all you have to do is send in a note or a form that's included in most issues with your name, address, phone number and congregation along with a check for \$5.00 and you will start receiving your subscription via US Mail. A subscription is for one year. You can sign up for more than one year at a time. Just do the math and send a check that equals \$5.00 for each year. We have also moved the Canyon Echoes into the electronic age.

Earnestlee: How did you do that? Is Scotty going to beam it into our mailboxes?

For our sisters who prefer to receive an electronic copy, they can send me their email address and a check for \$2.00 and they will start receiving Canyon Echoes in the inbox of their email accounts.
