Memories from 30<sup>th</sup> Convention/Gathering "The Three W's of JUST Love: Why, Where, When" (and **WHO**) November 10-12, 2023

Advent and Holyday Greetings,

Are you still breathless and overwhelmed from our recent Convention/Gathering at the Holiday Inn and Conference Center in Mesa, AZ? We may have been small, but we were mighty with all of the inspirational speakers who gave us knowledge and ideas of how we could be doing God's work. Some of the highlights:

- Recognizing our native land with readings by Wanda Frenchman, Oglala Lakota and Lenape, and Patty Charley, Navajo.
- Lutheran Advocacy Ministry of Arizona (LAMA) is doing great work to advocate for justice in areas of hunger, voting rights and water rights in the state of Arizona, and how we can be in touch with our elected officials and join in Lutheran Day at the Legislature at the Arizona Capitol on Thursday, January 18 @ 9:30-1:30.
- In partnership with Lutheran Social Service of the SW, the Interfaith Homeless Lodging Program (I-HELP) is providing a safe haven for people who find themselves homeless and helps them move from crisis to stability.
- StreetlightUSA is providing a faith based, holistic healing place for adolescent female survivors of child sexual exploitation and trafficking. This program gives survivors a place to dream, be empowered, and live a full and enriching life.
- ♥ Watching "Kiss the Ground" film opened our eyes to what we are doing to the earth. . .and how we must wake up and make a difference.
- How we can support the shelter for asylum seekers, La Casa de la Misericordia y Todas la Naciones in Nogales, Sonora, Mexico. A good start was the car load on In Kind gifts and financial donations provided during the Convention/Gathering.
- ♥ What's all this about **JUSTICE**?
- How can we breathe (CPR) life into our Women's Ministries?
- Calm Brain Gym exercise and meditation helped relax our minds and muscles.
- An overachieving Chef provided meals to help us forget about our **diets**.
- Music from Faith/La Fe El Coro Choir had us all singing in Spanish! And that amazing 8-year-old, Yzael, would make any grandma want to give him a hug! (which I did)
- Around the Grand Canyon Synod with Bishop Deborah with a film that introduced us to parts of Arizona, Southern Nevada, and Southern Utah where many of us have never traveled.
- Hands on blessing of Pastor Kim as she retires and enters a new phase of life.

- Relaxing **Taizé** service to end the day lead by Cyndy, our musical programming extraordinaire.
- ♥ A LOVE offering collection of \$2,200.00 to provide scholarships and more educational programming for Women of the Grand Canyon Synod!


Praying you all have a BLESSED Holyday season filled with LOVE. . . that which you receive and that which you give away – THE BEST present ever!

#### What is Katie's Fund?

Katharina von Bora Luther was a practical and bold woman of faith. In the beginning, Lutherans knew Katie Luther as the wife of Martin Luther. When Women of the ELCA first established the Katharina von Bora Luther Fund Endowment in 1997. Katie was a mystery to many. But over the years, through resources, scholarships, articles, and skits, Women of the ELCA told the story of this bold and brave woman who brewed beer, raised cattle, managed a busy household, and kept a theologian in line. These days, Katie Luther is loved and admired by those who know her. Many women see a bit of themselves in this legend who wore many bonnets. Through Katie's Fund, Women of the ELCA honors her life by supporting global connections, leadership development and faith formation. This endowment supports women's ministry in areas not funded through our annual operating budget.

#### **Building a future**

2122: Growing Katie's Fund for the next 100 years is a one-million-dollar campaign for Katie's Fund initiated in 2021 and designed to support the organization into the next 100 years of mission and ministry. Gifts can be made through one-time gifts or pledges to be completed over three years. The campaign will continue until we reach the \$1,000,000 goal. To-date, we're nearly 1/3 of the way to reach this goal!!

For 25 years, women have given to Katie's Fund to support and sustain the ministries of Women of the ELCA. And the organization hopes giving will last far into the future. The Fund is used to raise bold leaders for the women's organization and support creative ministry for generations to come. Those ministries run the gamut from enabling women to attend advocacy and immersion events to educating young people about human trafficking at ELCA Youth Gatherings. The ministry funds include providing scholarships for young women to participate in Women of the ELCA triennial gatherings and supporting documentaries about vital women's issues. Grants from Katie's Fund have helped create documentaries about domestic violence and workshops about bullying. ### It all starts with you! Looking for ideas about how to get involved in women's ministry in your church, in your community and beyond? Here are just some examples of how to begin:

- Support the LWR Quilt and Kit shipping fund
- Challenge your congregation to support the <u>alleluiabetterchancediapercloset.org</u>
- Start a faith-based book discussion—over lunch, or maybe over a glass of wine
- Contact your local community college or university support out of town students with a meal during exam week, or during holiday breaks
- Do you knit, crochet, quilt? Contact the Volunteer Services office at your nearby hospital; perhaps they need lap blankets, or baby caps or newborn layettes, etc. Begin knitting for the Knitted Knockers Program
- Start a ministry at a nearby Women's Prison, or a facility housing incarcerated immigrants. A Bible study, or magazines or books? Maybe subscriptions to our Gather magazine? A prayer group? Contact the facility's Chaplain
- · Learn to speak Spanish and connect with the Latina women in your community
- · Volunteer to accompany immigrants during court proceedings
- Donate clothing appropriate for work to the Native American Urban Ministry clothes closet, along with glasses, shoes, and feminine hygiene products, at Grace Lutheran in Phoenix
- Support the Navajo Mission in Rock Point, AZ https://nelm.org
- Support border ministries' needs in Tucson or Yuma area







Women were first ordained in the Lutheran Church in the U.S. in 1970.

The Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) was officially formed in

1987. Herbert Chilstrom was elected the first Bishop.

The Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church (**WELCA**) was separately incorporated in 1988. <u>ALL</u> monetary support comes **TOTALLY** from the women themselves!!!!

The Reverand Deborah Hutterer was the first woman to be elected Bishop of the Grand Canyon Synod!

**SWO** – Synodical Women's Organizations are located in 64 of the ELCA's 65 synods. The only synod without a synodical organization is the Slovak Zion Synod, the ELCA's only non-geographical synod!

**CWO** – Churchwide Women's Organization located in Chicago, IL (womenoftheelca.org)

**GCS (2D)** – Grand Canyon Synod comprising of nine conferences located in Southern Utah, Southern Nevada, and all of Arizona. (gcsynod.org)
